

Dear Parents/Carer's

Problems with parking down the lane has escalated in the past few weeks and we have received complaints from residents and school parents about inconsiderate parking. We are in consultation with the Police on the parking situation.

The access and parking to our school is limited so we have a few parking protocols that will make everyone's life easier at school pick up times.

- Please keep your speed down and supervise your children when they have got out of the car or walking to your car.
- Park facing down the lane and on the left hand only. Try not to park past the path to the Cricket pitch as you will cause an obstruction. Parking in this area will not allow space for cars to come up and down the lane and also causes a problem for pedestrians.
- Do not park in the turning circle at the end of the lane, this is an access point to an industrial area and in constant use.
- The staff car park is not to be used for parents parking.
- There are two disabled spaces in the staff car park. These are for blue badge holders who are visiting the school only. If any pre-school parents are blue badge holders, permission must be gained from the school before using these spaces.
- You must not block or partially block the entrance to the staff car park or use this as a turning circle.
- Do not block or park on any residents driveways.
- The entrance to the staff car park should not be used for pedestrian access.
- There is a hidden ditch on the left hand side of the road. If your car goes into it, it may damage the underside and need towing out. Be mindful of not forcing other cars into this ditch.
- If you are parking in the lane for an extended time that is in not in relation to a school event, please consider parking at the village hall.
- If family and friends pick up your child, please ensure that they are aware of the parking situation and abide by these protocols.

This is a private road, we are only allowed to park outside with the agreement that we are mindful of the people who live and work in the area.
